We, the jury, find for Lorrie Angel, Plenary Guardian of Michael Angel, a Disabled Person; and Lorrie Angel, Individually and against the defendant, Howard Michael Segal, M.D.

We further find the following:

The reasonable expense of necessary medications received \$ 72,000.00

The reasonable expense of necessary medications to be received in the future \$ 685,000.00

The pain and suffering experienced \$ —

The pain and suffering reasonably certain to be experienced in the future \$ —

The loss of normal life experienced \$ 100,000

The loss of normal life reasonably certain to be experienced in the future \$ 550,000

Shortened life expectancy \$ —

The increased risk of future harm resulting from Michael Angel taking antipsychotics for the rest of his life expectancy is itemized as follows:

The metabolic syndrome, diabetes, high cholesterol and heart conditions to be experienced in the future \$ 250,000.00

The LIKELIHOOD that the future harm will occur is 50 %.

The TOTAL DAMAGES multiplied by the LIKELIHOOD that they are going to occur is:

$$\frac{250,000.00}{\text{TOTAL DAMAGES}} \times \frac{50}{\text{LIKELIHOOD}} \% = \underline{\$125,000.00}$$
